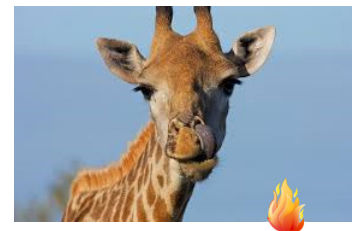

Please, **BE WATER WISE**

Here are some tips for conserving water and keeping your monthly bill manageable.

INSIDE

If your shower fills a one gallon bucket in less than 20 seconds, replace the showerhead with a WaterSense®-labeled model.



Re-purpose the bucket of water into your garden.

OUTSIDE

SUMMER is just around the corner, are you prepared for irrigation season?

Water your plants deeply but less frequently to encourage deep root growth and drought tolerance.

Adjusting your irrigation schedule monthly can reduce your outdoor water use as much as 50 percent.

Use a clay “olla” watering vessel (pronounced oya) when watering thirty plants. Submerge the vessel in the soil amidst plants with the neck of the vessel above soil. Fill with water and then cover or cap the top with lid or stone to prevent mosquito breeding. The soil will draw water from the olla gradually. Refill as necessary.
