Effective October 1st, you will only be billed for the water you use at a per a thousand gallon rate.


# **ROADS - Parking**

# Please, BE WATER WISE

The first step in changing the way you use water in the future is by understanding how much water you use today. The best place to find this information is on your monthly water bill.

### Compare past bills

How much do you use? What is your water usage trend?

### What is included in your monthly bill?

The City of Cascade bills water and sewer on the same bill. These costs are roughly 50 / 50 plus charges for the water that you use.
