AB 22-109 Engineering update presented by City Engineer, Trevor Howard (Action Item)

Trevor Howard summarized his May 20, 2022 letter to Council outlining existing projects and projects in the works where engineering services are required. He asked Council for other questions regarding general professional services; there were none.

There was further discussion regarding engineering services for the River District, Front Street, storm water, city shop, and golf course irrigation projects. He explained to Council that the more successful the grant funding the more competitive the City can be.
