Lake Cascade Update

Samples taken at Cascade Lake last week indicate the presence of toxins in the water. The <u>Central District Health</u> determined that the levels are below the health advisory threshold at this time.

It is important to remember that toxins can be present at varying concentrations throughout a water body and can pose a risk to people and animals. Changes in the weather can also impact bloom locations and toxin concentrations. DEQ always urges caution when recreating in and around water during the hot summer months.


