## Please, **BE WATER WISE**

### FUNDING DRINKING WATER SYSTEM IMPROVEMENTS

The City is still seeking funds to complete the needed drinking water system improvements. The Water Facility Planning Study (FPS) prepared in October of 2021 estimated cost to make needed improvements to the water system to be \$3.4 million.

When the Idaho Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) ranked applications for ARPA (American Rescue Plan Act) and SRF funds, the City of Cascade ended up falling *just* outside of the ARPA fundable list. A total of 72 systems will be offered ARPA funding, and Cascade ended up ranking #78. Cascade may still be offered funding because it is common for some fundable projects to forfeit funds they are offered. 

Cascade may be offered ARPA grant funds to pay for 50% of the water system improvements and a low interest loan from State Revolving Funds (SRF). To receive these funds, we must be able to legally incur debt by December 2022.

You will see a water bond on the November ballot for \$4 million. We continue to seek additional funds from the Idaho Department of Commerce, the US Department of Agriculture Rural Development, and other agencies to reduce how much money we need to borrow to complete the needed improvements. By passing a bond in this amount, we will have the flexibility to complete the entire project if we do not receive any other funding.

**ROADS - Parking** The City of Cascade would like to remind you to keep the streets clear for snow removal operations. **Cascade City Code (7-2-2)** limits parking of motor vehicles on any street or alley within the City for a period of no longer than two (2) hrs. **SNOW / SLUSH - and MUD REMOVAL Cascade City Code (5-7-1)** It is the responsibility of the Owners/Occupants of businesses fronting Main St. to remove snow, slush and mud from the sidewalks within 24 hours of occurrence.
