Propane Tank Safety - Use a broom instead of a shovel when clearing snow off the tank or around the exposed piping, regulator, gauges, or tubing.



When clearing the roof, avoid shoveling snow onto exposed piping around the propane regulator near the building or onto the propane tank and piping, as well as any meters or other piping that may be in use.

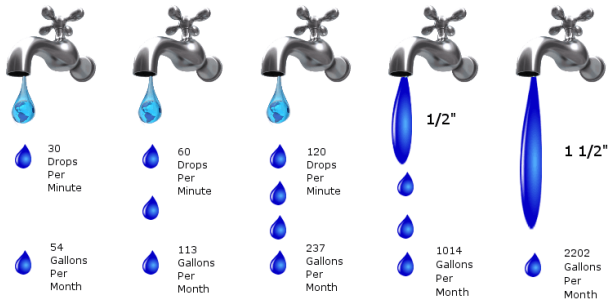


Please, **BE WATER WISE**

Monthly Water Testing Results

Public utilities are required by law to take many expensive samples each month. They also must pay the employees that run them, as well as cover administrative costs.

The City of Cascade tests drinking water based on requirements specific to our permit. The testing locations are dictated by Idaho DEQ based on our system. Water testing occurs in areas with close proximity to our gravity fed tanks and end of the line locations.

The City of Cascade would like to remind you to keep the streets clear for snow removal operations.

Cascade City Code (7-2-1) prohibits parking of motor vehicles on any street or alley within the City during the winter season between the hours of **2:00 AM & 6:00 AM**.

SNOW / SLUSH and MUD REMOVAL

Cascade City Code (5-7-1)

It is the responsibility of the Owners/Occupants of businesses fronting Main St. to remove snow, slush and mud from the sidewalks within 24 hours of occurrence.
