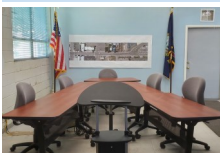

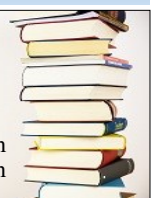

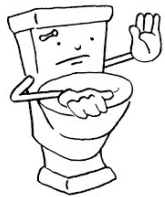




Please, **BE WATER WISE**

Is your home used as a vacation or short term rental either full time or part time? Consider posting or including in your guest book the following guidelines and tips to help protect your plumbing and maintain the City's wastewater system working efficiently.

Non-flush items like cleaning cloths, masks, wipes and diapers cause wear and tear to a lift station pump and are time consuming to remove. **KEEP COSTS DOWN**, don't flush disposables; only toilet paper.

Water and Winter

Drip Faucets ~ Prevent Leaks ~ Conserve



For every 10 miles per hour of speed, try to keep a distance of one car length between you and the vehicle in front. See a plow? Give them extra room to do their job.

WINTER PARKING, SNOW and SLUSH REMOVAL

ROADS - Parking

The City of Cascade would like to remind you to keep the streets clear for snow removal operations.

Cascade City Code (7-1)

limits parking of motor vehicles on any street or alley within the City for a period of no longer than two 2 hrs.

SNOW / SLUSH -and MUD REMOVAL

Cascade City Code (5-7-1)

It is the responsibility of the Owners/Occupants of businesses fronting Main St. to remove snow, slush and mud from the sidewalks within 24 hours of occurrence.

Snow and Bermed Driveways

On 2/12/2016 this topic was discussed at a City Council Meeting and it was determined that to plow every driveway would not be feasible due to limited staff, budget constraints and fairness to tax payers.
