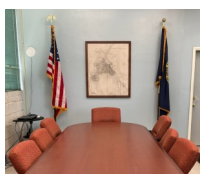

WINTER PARKING, SNOW and SLUSH REMOVAL

ROADS - Parking

The City of Cascade would like to remind you to keep the streets clear for snow removal operations.

Cascade City Code (7-2-2)

limits parking of motor vehicles on any street or alley within the City for a period of no longer than two 2 hrs.

SNOW / SLUSH -and MUD REMOVAL

Cascade City Code (5-7-1)

It is the responsibility of the Owners/Occupants of businesses fronting Main St. to remove snow, slush and mud from the sidewalks within 24 hours of occurrence.



Monthly Water Testing Results

Public utilities are required by law to take many expensive samples each month. They also must pay the employees that run them, as well as cover administrative costs.

The City of Cascade tests drinking water based on requirements specific to our permit. The testing locations are dictated by Idaho DEQ based on our water distribution system. Water testing occurs in areas with close proximity to our gravity fed tanks and end of the line locations.

FY 2025/2026 Water and Sewer **Rate Increase**

Water Base Rate from \$17.29 to \$18.15 = **\$.86 increase**
 Water Imprv. #2 from \$.00 to \$ 7.00 = **\$7.00 increase**
 (improvement #2 is water Bond passed in 2023)

Sewer Base Rate from \$28.91 to \$31.35 = **\$2.44 increase**

All new rates, effective October 1, 2025, will be reflected on your November bill for October service.

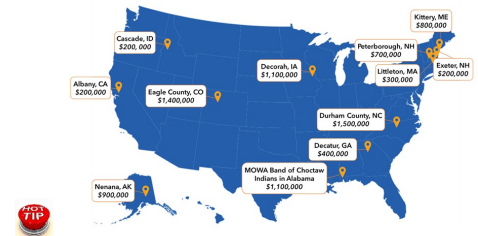

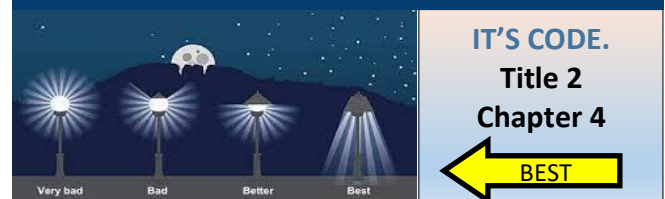
